《Entry through MEXT Scholarship》------

Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) Scholarship Program **(University Recommendation)** is offered for Degree Programs (see below).

- Time for enrollment: October 2017
- Number of applicants to be selected: Up to 8
- Period of eligibility check: September 1 (Thu) October 20 (Thu), 2016
- Application fee: None
- Application period: October 21 (Fri) November 4 (Fri), 2016
- Selection method: Documentation screening and internet interview
- ➤ Interview period: November 14 (Mon) December 8 (Thu), 2016
- Announcement of successful applicants: December 26 (Mon), 2016

MEXT Scholarship covers airfare and tuition, with a stipend for living expenses (~147,000 JPY/month). Estimated success rate: Greater than 25%

- MEXT Scholarship can be applied for through <u>Embassy Recommendation</u> as well. Please contact the appropriate Japanese diplomatic mission in your country for details.
- After being selected as a successful candidate, you do not need to take entrance exams.

Degree Programs

Global Frontier in Life Science (Self-funded course) Master's (2 years) and Doctoral (3 years)

This program is held in English, including the entrance examinations, lectures, experiments, and discussions. Enrollment: 1st October and 1st April. Details of the entrance examination for AY2017-2018 will be announced on our website around December 2016.

Tentative Schedule

- Deadlines: <Eligibility Screening> April 2017, <Application> May 2017
- Documentation Screening: June 2017
- Interview (via Internet): June to July 2017
- Announcement of Successful Applicants: End of July 2017

Note: Applicants are NOT required to be physically present in Japan for the examination. Before submitting the application, applicants must contact the faculty director (PI) of the laboratory they would like to join and fully discuss potential research activities and availability.
