Re: Degree Conferment Ceremony

The information for the degree conferment ceremony will be directly sent to the awardee by post from the Student Affairs Division of the Kyoto University approximately 10 days before the month to be conferred.

The ceremonies are held twice in September and March, annually. For conferment in May, July, and September, the ceremony will be held in September. For conferment in November, January, and March, the ceremony will be held in March.
